# Course Description Overview

## SKILLS TRAINING

### Aerial Lift – 8 hrs

- Introduction to Safe Operating Procedures while using an Aerial Lift
- Identification of different types of lifts
- Aerial lift fall protection and safety inspections

### Blueprint Reading – 40 hrs

- Introduction to basic blueprint reading
- Light commercial, commercial and highway heavy prints
- Blueprint specifications

### Concrete Practices and Procedures – 40 hrs

- Introduction to concrete practices
- Mix proportioning, mineral and chemical add mixtures, Forming systems, sub grade preparation
- Vibrating, placing and curing of concrete

### Dingo Training – 8 hrs

- Introduction to walk behind bobcat skidster operations
- Maintenance & Inspections of the walk behind skidster

### Fall Protection – 8 hrs

- This course covers all types of fall protection systems
- Guardrails, nets, hole covers, personal fall arrest
- Controlled access zones, warning lines, safety monitors, written fall protection plans

### Flagging / MnDOT – 4 hrs

- This course covers rules and responsibilities of flagging
  - Basic understanding of traffic control devices and layouts
- \*Note: 4 hr Refresher required every 4 years**

### Gas Pipe Fusion – 8hrs

- Pipe fusion equipment/safety considerations
- Butt & Electro fusion techniques
- Testing procedures

### GPS – 24hrs

- Principles of operation
  - Coordinates
  - Measuring control points & staking
- \*Prerequisites: Line & Grade I & 2**

### Gen-Con – 40 hrs

- Introduction course to the fundamentals of the construction industry
  - Gas, electric, pneumatic tools, material recognition, flagging/ traffic control
  - Compaction, torch cutting, construction math, hand signals, pro-10
- \*Note: Mandatory for all Apprentices**

### Heavy Highway Skills – 40 hrs

- Introduction course of jobsite tasks and heavy highway skills
- Heavy highway blueprint reading, material estimation, instrument layout
- Flagging/ traffic control

### Infection Control Risk Assessment (ICRA) – 16 hrs

- Introduction to patient risks of construction activities in a hospital
- Construction barriers, negative air pressure, housekeeping, PPE, ILSM

### Landscape Concepts & Principles – 40 hrs

- Introduction to basic landscape concepts
- Plant & tree protection & installation, soil types
- Site prep & planting techniques, edging, aggregate pathways & sod

### Line & Grade I – 40 hrs

- Introduction to basic line & grade duties & instruments
- Instrument layout, grade checking, elevation control and line & grade math

### Line & Grade II – 40 hrs

- Advance training in line & grade duties & instruments
  - Instrument layout, grade checking, elevation control and line & grade math
- \*Prerequisites: Line & Grade I**

### Mason Tending – 40 hrs

- Understanding of mason tender responsibilities and safety
- Mortar mixing, scaffold usage, material handling, block saw, hand tool recognition

### Pipelaying I – 40 hrs

- Introduction to sewer and water industry
- Utility line & grade, gravity flow basics, pressure piping systems basics
- Introduction to pipe lasers, pipe fusion techniques

### Pipelaying II – 40 hrs

- Advance Pipe laying techniques for the sewer & water industry
  - Utility staking, utility testing procedures, sediment & erosion control
  - Excavation/ confined space training, blue print reading
  - Math calculations for line & grade, MN state plumbing code (blue card)
- \*Prerequisites: Pipelaying I**

### Pipeline Technology – 40 hrs

- Introduction to natural gas and petroleum pipeline construction
- Utility locating techniques, site grading, fence building, pipe stringing
- Pipe preparation, pipe coating, testing and cathodic protection

### Plumbing Code – 4 hrs

- MN Department of Health plumbing codes (blue card)
  - Plumbing codes relevant to work outside to the property line or foundation
- \*Prerequisites: Pipelaying I & II**  
**\*Note: 4 hr Refresher required every 3 years**

### Remote Camera Inspection / Trenchless Pipe Renovation – 32 hrs

- Proper operation and maintenance, use of remote cutters
- Jetting & pipe cleaning techniques, pipe & manhole re-lining and replacement

### Rigging and Signaling Qualified – 24 hrs

- OSHA safety procedures on performing rigging and signaling
- Advanced math for rigging problems
- Volumes, weight calculations, sling tension and center of gravity

### Scaffold Erecting – 40 hrs

- Basic knowledge of various types of scaffold erecting & sheltering techniques
- System scaffold, rolling tower scaffold, tube & clamp and frame scaffold
- Scaffold competent person card upon achieving 80% or better on final exam

### Supervisor Training & Education Program (STEP 1) - 40 hrs

- Supervisor leadership techniques in construction
  - Communication techniques, construction math, job safety and hazard analysis
  - Project organization and documentation, problem solving and human relations
- \*Prerequisites: Level 3 Apprentices and Journeyworkers**

### SWPPP Installer (Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan) – 8 hrs

- MPCA & U of M installer certification
  - Installation & maintenance practices for sediment/ erosion control
- \*Note: U of M fee for certification card good for 3 years**

### SWPPP Manager (Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan) – 16 hrs

- MPCA & U of M site manager certification
  - Supervision for installation & maintenance for sediment/ erosion control
  - 8 hr refresher every 3 years
- \*Note: U of M fee for certification card good for 3 years**

### Telecomm Installer (Orange Card) – 40 hrs

- Utility Locating and Blueprint Reading
- Vac Trailer Safety & Operation
- Confined Space/Flagging
- Horizontal Directional Drilling

### Torch Cutting Demo Safety – 16 hrs

- Torch set-up, safety, and hands-on torch cutting demolition techniques

### Vacuum Trailer Training – 8 hrs

- Ring-O-Matic 550 Vacuum Trailer operations & safety
- Metro Tech operations & safety
- Utility locating

### Welding – 200 hrs

- Introduction to Air Arc, wire feed, flux core & tig welding
  - Torch cutting demo techniques & safety
  - 5 welding credits from state vocational system upon course completion
  - Welding certifications received upon proficiency test completion
- \*Prerequisites: Apprentices must complete Safety Week & General Construction**

### Asbestos Air Sampling – 16 hrs

- Asbestos air sampling techniques that meet MN State and Federal regulations
- \*Prerequisites: Asbestos Worker or Supervisor Initial**

### Asbestos Abatement Training

- Asbestos Inspector Initial – 24 hrs
  - Asbestos Inspector Refresher – 4 hrs
  - Asbestos Worker Initial – 32 Hours
  - Asbestos Worker Refresher – 8 Hours
  - Asbestos Supervisor Initial – 40 Hours
  - Asbestos Supervisor Refresher – 8 Hours
  - Asbestos training meets all MN State and Federal regulations
- \*Asbestos Inspector Initial: Must prove 500 hrs of asbestos related work or Safety**
- \*Asbestos Worker Initial: Must prove 1,000 hrs of construction related experience**
- \*Asbestos Supervisor Initial: Must prove 2,000 hrs of construction related experience**
- \*Note: Certification requires a state fee**

- Hazwoper Initial – 40 hrs
- Hazwoper Refresher – 8 hrs
- This course covers 29 CFR 1910.120/29 and CFR 1926.65

### Lead Training

- Lead Worker Initial – 24 hrs
  - Lead Worker Refresher – 8 hrs
  - Lead Supervisor Initial – 32 hrs
  - Lead Supervisor Refresher – 8 hrs
  - Lead Renovator, Remodeler, Painter (RRP) Initial – 16 hrs
  - Lead Renovator, Remodeler, Painter (RRP) Refresher – 8 hrs
  - Lead Training meets all MN State and Federal Regulations
- \*Lead Supervisor: Must prove 1 year experience as a lead worker/ or 2 years construction related experience**
- \*Note: License requires a state fee**

## SAFETY TRAINING

### CPR/ First Aid – 8 hrs

- Basic CPR/ First Aid training and AED
- \*Note: Recertification required every 2 years**

### Excavation / Confined Space – 8 hrs

- Introduction to the hazards & safety of excavations & confined spaces
- \*Note: Refresher required annually**

### Mine Safety / Health Administration (MSHA)

- MSHA 24 / New Miner – 24 hrs
- MSHA 8 / Experienced Miner Refresher - 8 hrs
- Introduction to the hazards & safety associated with mine property
- This course meets all MSHA rules & regulations

### Safety Week – 40 hrs

- Safety course that includes OSHA 30
  - Fall protection awareness, scaffold user, excavation / confined space, fire watch
  - Silica awareness, lead awareness, asbestos awareness, CPR / First Aid
- \*Note: Mandatory for all Apprentices**

## SPECIALTY TRAINING

Contractors who are signatory to the Laborers Union may contact the Director of Training to inquire about specialty training offerings which include: Asbestos Awareness 4-hrs, Asbestos O & M 16-hrs, Construction Math 8-hrs, Fork Truck Awareness 4-hrs, Lead Awareness 4-hrs, Light Rail 8-hrs, Microbial Remediation/Mold 24-hrs, Pipe Fusion 8-hrs, Plaster Tending, PRO-10 10-hrs, Scaffold User 8-hrs, Silica Awareness.

Whenever possible, contractors are encouraged to plan ahead for specialty training to ensure the availability of personnel and resources to accommodate requests. Specialty training is at the discretion of the Director of Training.

## IMPORTANT NOTES

**Plumbing Code / Pipe Layers Card:** The Minnesota State Plumbing Code (Pipe Layers Card) requires attending a 4 hour refresher to renew your card.

**Spanish Training Courses:** A limited number of courses are available in Spanish by contractor request. Please contact the Director of Training to inquire.
